Introduction

In the same way opportunities are stepping stones, starting something from home does not mean you never leave! I wanted to take this down to the simplest solution for everyone, so it doesn't matter if you are housebound, in a remote area or have commitments that limit your ability to leave the house, you still have a way to make money.

You can choose how to work or run your business. Do everything online, or only work from home part-time. Connect with your employers and clients online or meet them in the physical world.

Make It Legal

The ideas listed in this book are just that - ideas. When you have narrowed down the opportunities you want to investigate further, don't forget to find out how to do it legally. The last thing you need is to get into trouble with the local council or the tax office!

Some things you need to find out about include (but are not limited to):

Permits

Are you allowed to run a business from your home? What permits do you need?

Insurance

Do you need to change your insurance if you are running a business from home? Make sure you are fully covered for any stock and equipment losses.

Tax

How are you going to receive the income you make and how do you have to declare it? Remember, if you are not working for an employer, you need to take care of the accounting requirements yourself.

In some countries/regions/cities you will need one thing and in others it could be completely different.

But and other excuses

So many people say they can't work from home.

Just like me saying I can't be consistent, I can't stick to habits etc. Deep down it's because I don't have enough motivation to put the required effort in. For me that motivation has to be because I enjoy something/find it interesting or my back is against the wall and I have no other choice.

I am going to guess most other people are the same to different degrees.

So let's look at some reasons people say they can't start something on their own, try something new, or make a change in their circumstances.

...I don't have experience

It's true, some positions will ask for people with experience so you have several options:

- Have you done anything similar that you could put forward as experience?
- Can you do any courses to get the skills you need?
- Can you do any voluntary work to get the experience you need?
- Do you want this job or business badly enough to do any of the above? If not, move on to the next opportunity.

...I don't have time

You may not have a lot of time but you always have some time available. The trick is not having hours each day free to start something new. I'm doing a little each day. Momentum. When you are pushing a rock up a hill, if you have to start from the bottom each time, it will take you much longer to get to the top - if you ever make it past the exhaustion and frustration of having to start again each time.

- Is there anything you can stop doing to work on your alternative income instead? Hint: television and social media are huge time leeches you can cut down dramatically.
- Is there any time you can use to learn something new by reading, listening to audio books or podcasts? For example, on your commute to work, waiting for appointments, waiting to pick the kids up, exercising, doing the housework, etc.

...I don't have the energy

Many experts say it is more important to manage your energy than it is to manage your time. If you have no energy, it doesn't matter how much time you have. You won't be able to concentrate or keep that momentum going if you are exhausted. So if energy is a problem see what you can do to increase it.

- Do you need to change what you are eating?
- Do you need to get more sleep? Better quality sleep?
- Do you have any health issues you need to get help with?
- Do you do any exercise?

...I don't have any money to invest in the business.

You just need to adjust your definition of a 'business'. For me, being a little older and still remembering the days before the internet, a business was a physical building, with stock, staff and all the costs that go with it.

If you are not online much, you might also have that idea....but it's wrong.

There are businesses to start with little or no money, for example dropshipping where you can sell products and only pay the supplier once you have the money from the client.

You can start teaching or coaching others with no website or social media presence. All it takes is for you to help one person locally to get started.

Scaling up is all about starting small and growing the business. That doesn't have to mean big investments or loans. If you have the time and the patience you can wait until you earn some money from what you are doing and only use those profits to build up the business.

...it's too lonely working from home

Just because you can make money without leaving home does not mean you never leave the house. It is about choice. You have the option to work from home, but you can still expand your business, go out to meet clients, go to the gym, meet your friends, etc.

You are saving the time you would waste commuting to and from work and ineffective time at work. Which means working from home could give you more time to enjoy yourself, just don't go down the rabbit hole of living and working at home but never doing anything else. Balance is the key.

...most of the jobs are not in my area.

It can seem like that although more and more companies are seeing the benefits for their profits and productivity to have employees working from home. The UK and Europe also have a lot of opportunities available for telecommute jobs, remote working and freelancing, you just have to look for them. Check them out anyway, a lot of companies hire remote telecommuters from all over the world.

...I don't have the confidence to do it.

OK, this is probably the most difficult obstacle to overcome. We limit ourselves and what we can do so it can be hard to try something new. There is no magic pill for this one other than to take one step after another. You have already done that by reading this book and when you are triggered by one of the opportunities you see, you will take the next step by researching it further.

Don't judge yourself by what other people do, how fast they do it or how successful they are. You are on your own unique path, with unique circumstances... just keep going.

Is It Really True?

This is what you have to ask yourself whenever you dismiss something without really looking into it.

If there are obstacles in your way and you find yourself saying "I can't do that" ask yourself "Is it really true?"

- Can you learn the skills you need?
- Can you get someone to help you?
- Even if you can't do it right now, could you do it further down the line?

If you answer yes, then you should keep it on your list for the future. You never know what you might find yourself doing once you have more experience and more confidence!

Stepping Stones

Starting any of these opportunities can seem like a pointless exercise, one that brings in little financial reward, or simply takes too long to get off the ground.

You need to keep an open mind when you start and see each thing you try as a stepping stone. Whatever you try, you are gaining experience, contacts and knowledge that could lead you on to the next upgrade.

You may start small. It may be difficult, or boring or even soul destroying, but it's just the start. There are so many ways you can go as long as you keep learning.

- Telecommute secretary > Freelance Virtual Assistant > VA Business
- Article writer at a content farm > Freelance Writer > Content Marketing Business
- Sell stock photography > Sell prints > Open an ecommerce store
- Hobby gardener > Sell Organic Produce > Create a course about growing organic food

You get the idea.

How Much Money Can You Make?

Telecommuting, freelancing and running your own business overlap on the income scale and in the same way, different ways of earning income also overlap. Someone telecommuting as a part-time transcriptionist will be at the lower end, but someone telecommuting as an engineer could be at the top end. Someone who has written a book but only sells a few copies will be on the lower end, while someone who consistently publishes books can start earning much more.

The scale below is in no way definitive and is only meant to give you an idea of different options available. The amount you make will mostly depend on how much time you invest in the project, in your education and expanding on your opportunity.

Highlight anything that sounds interesting to you but don't be swayed only by what could make you the most money. You want to enjoy it as well. You could start off working for someone else at the lower end then start your own business offering that service directly and employing other people to help you.

Money Makers

Now we finally get to the opportunities. Browse through them casually and pay attention to how you feel when you read them.

Put it on your shortlist if you find yourself saying any of the following:

- I hadn't thought of that.
- Hmm... that sounds interesting.
- I wish I could do that.
- I like the sound of that but I don't have the skills/equipment.
- I would do that if I had more time/had more confidence/had more money....
- It's not ideal but....

You want a list of **possibilities** to narrow down later. Do not let the demons of doubt put you off! The ones you should ignore are those that leave you cold or you know you would hate!
